Gail was a dedicated volunteer in the Klamath County Cattlewomen, known especially for her delectable pies at the Klamath Bull Sale bake sale. Gail was also an accomplished musician and enjoyed performing with her flute. The Klamath County Cattlewomen are proud to continue her legacy by awarding musically-inclined agriculture students with funding for their educational programs. We are pleased to announce that several scholarships will be available this year for eligible students. The amounts vary, with no less than \$500 awarded.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants (either men or women) must be a resident of the Klamath Basin and a student of a local high school or homeschool program. This includes all of Klamath County, Tulelake, and Butte Valley areas of Siskiyou and Modoc Counties.
2. Applicants are a high school senior, current college student, or current trade school student.
3. Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
4. Eligible students will be those who are **majoring in, or working toward a career that will benefit Agriculture**. This may include, but is not limited to: Large Animal Veterinary Medicine, Nutrition, Fabrication, Agri-business, Ag Communication, Ranch Management, Agronomy, Diesel Mechanics, Agri- Law, Ag Education, Culinary School, etc.
5. Students will also show **recent, consistent interest in music**, whether at a casual or more structured level. Examples include two or more years of music lessons, participation in a band, orchestra, musical theater, or choir, or performing on a regular basis.

The scholarships are awarded on the basis of interests, future plans, activities, and evidence that the applicant shows promise in their intended field. Applications must be postmarked by **April 15**. An application form is attached. You may make additional copies, if needed.
